

# CAREER DEVELOPMENT INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

The goal of the Career Development Internship program is to expose transition-aged youth to opportunities within Los Angeles County and assist them in gaining the skills and knowledge necessary to compete for full-time permanent positions. Interns are hired to assist in a variety of training assignments of typically 12 to 24 months varying in duration based on individual training requirements.

Career Development Internships are made available in one of four specialties:

- ▶ Office Support/Clerical Intern
- ▶ Information Technology/Technical Support
- ▶ Craft Support
- ▶ Heavy Maintenance and Operational Support

## WHO QUALIFIES?

Applicants to the program must be currently enrolled in, or in completion of, the Department of Children and Family Services' and/or Probation Department's Independent Living Program. Those who are currently or were previously eligible for the Independent Living Program may also apply.

## PROGRAM BENEFITS

Interns who participate in the program will receive the following benefits:

- ▶ A full-time temporary position which pays a competitive salary
- ▶ Medical and dental benefits for the intern and his or her immediate family
- ▶ Paid vacation, paid holidays, sick leave, and bereavement leave.
- ▶ Life skills training and tools in preparation for a future with Los Angeles County as employed, engaged, and contributing citizens.

In the end, interns will be motivated, trained, and qualified employees capable of obtaining an entry-level position with County departments.
